

Quick Overview Guide

All criteria below must be achieved by 1st July 2017

Academic Success: 20 House Points

Students to gain 20 House Points for Academic Achievement.

Evidence: Signature or stamp from Mrs Haworth

Charity: Raise £5

Students to raise a total of £5 for Red-Aid or a charity of their choice. There will be opportunities within school to do this.

Evidence: Signature from Class Teacher

Service: 4 hours of service

This involves students being helpful to others and providing a service. Examples could include helping parents / carers with the shopping, tidying their bedroom, washing the car, volunteering to help in school etc. Anywhere the student can give 4 hours of their time

Faith: Worship/British Values

Students will be encouraged to promote fundamental British Values, to respect other students regardless of faith. Alternatively, students can lead an act of worship within Tutor time, such as a prayer.

Evidence: Signature from Class Teacher

Reliability: 95% attendance & punctuality

To attend school at all possible times. The 95% does not include medical appointments.

Evidence: Signature or stamp from Mrs Haworth

Extended Learning: 3 House Events

Must attend 3 House Events. These House Events are of the student's choice.
