

Quick Overview Guide

All criteria below must be achieved by 1st July 2017

Academic Success: 30 House Points

Students to gain 30 house points for Academic Achievement.

Evidence: Signature or stamp from Mrs Haworth

Charity: Raise £10

Students to raise a total of £10 for Red-Aid or a charity of their choice. There will be opportunities within school to do this.

Evidence: Signature from Class Teacher

Service: 6 hours of service

This involves students being helpful to others and providing a service. Examples could include helping parents / carers with the shopping, tidying their bedroom, washing the car, volunteering to help in school etc. Anywhere the student can give 6 hours of their time

Evidence: Signature from Class Teacher

British Values: 15 House Points

Students will be encouraged to promote fundamental British Values, to respect other students regardless of faith. Students to gain 15 house points for promoting British Values.

Evidence: Signature or stamp from Mrs Haworth

Redwood Values: 20 House Points

Students to gain 20 house points for promoting the Redwood Values: Be the best, Work hard, Be happy.

Evidence: Signature or stamp from Mrs Haworth

Mentor:

To offer a help in hand to year 7 students working towards their Redwoodian Award.

Evidence: Signature from Class Teacher

Reliability: 95% attendance & punctuality

To attend school at all possible times. The 95% does not include medical appointments.

Evidence: Signature or stamp from Mrs Haworth

Extended Learning: 5 House Events

Must attend 5 house events. These house events are of the student's choice. **Evidence: Signature from House Leader**
