BTEC INTRODUCTORY IN VOCATIONAL STUDIES

- Students will choose a BTEC course to focus on each year.
- The units are at Entry Level 1,2,3 and Level 1
- Students will work on scenarios based on the units and the chosen sector for 2 days a week each term (the sector can be changed at the end of the first year if necessary in consultation with the student, parents and staff)

Our intention is to encourage learners to:

- enjoy learning, gaining in confidence and promoting their learning in the future
- be inspired to take on further study
- take ownership of their learning by becoming engaged and seeing progression
- make informed decisions about the types of sectors and programmes to which they
- could progress.

Students will focus on the following skills in all aspects of the BTEC as well as gain a greater understanding of different vocational sectors by develop their skills gained in KS4:

Entry Level 1, 2 and 3

:	ommunication Writing, speaking and listening to others. Using body language to help communication. Using communication for different purposes.
:	orking with others Setting common goals. Showing respect for others in the team and valuing their contributions. Listening to others in the team, being open-minded. Taking on roles and responsibilities.
:	oblem solving Identifying issues by being able to examine information. Dealing with change. Decision-making to find solutions. Staying with a problem until it is resolved.
:	anaging and presenting information Collecting and using information. Checking accuracy of information. Organising information. Representing information in different ways.
:	elf-management and development Setting goals and planning ahead. Being flexible. Being resilient and able to work under pressure. Monitoring performance and devising strategies for improvement.

- Who? Year 12/13 mixed groups based on 'stage not age'
- Where? REEC
- **How?** 2 year rolling programme 2 days a week working on a half termly 'project' (BTEC briefs) focused on Construction and Horticulture skills and industries. They may also take part in the Rochdale Council gardening project.

- Incorporated Functional Literacy, Numeracy and ICT/ administration skills
- Gardening skills such as looking after and growing plants and keeping outside spaces clean and tidy
- Construction skills such a brick laying and woodwork
- DIY/ decorating skills
- Teamwork skills
