For learners on our Engage Pathway, the maths curriculum follows a learner-centred approach, using play, exploration, and real-life contexts to build early mathematical understanding in line with EHCP outcomes. The curriculum is designed to be flexible and responsive, with a focus on repetition, overlearning, and generalisation of skills.

Learners are regularly exposed to core mathematical concepts such as number, shape, space, measure, and pattern through hands-on, practical activities. Mathematical language is embedded across the day, supporting the development of early problem-solving and thinking skills.

Daily routines and structured tasks offer opportunities to explore time, sequencing, quantity, and comparison, all tailored to individual learning profiles. The curriculum promotes confidence and independence in using maths to make sense of the world around them
