Internship Success!

UPTURN Enterprise have been working with the Internship and Mcdonalds to unlock the potential and improve the lives and the health & wellbeing of people from Oldham and Rochdale.

Case study from Gail (talent coach from UPTURN):

I contacted McDonalds in Rochdale to ask about their Community Connections Project and whether it would be suitable for a group of Redwood Students to take part in. After an initial call with Jon (restaurant manager), we had a meeting to discuss what we could put together. Myself and Jon put together a basic training workshop for the students to complete. The workshop provided the opportunity for 3 students to work 1 morning a week for 4 weeks at Mc Donalds. This enabled them to be trained in each area of the restaurant and taught how to use the various equipment, they would receive basic McDonalds induction training and work on some interview techniques. After the 4 weeks, the students would receive a certificate of completion. This project has given the students valuable work experience; they have gained many transferrable skills and a much-needed confidence boost. The staff at the Kingsway McDonalds have all been very supportive and accommodating. The students were made to feel part of the team and really enjoyed their time working there. A special thankyou to Jon, Faisal, and Steven for going that extra mile. Due to the success of the past 4 weeks, we are hoping to extend the programme to allow more students to take part in the future.
