

Formal: Boost, English

Learners on the Boost provision follow a Formal curriculum which ensures that learners are appropriately stretched and challenged by incorporating skills needed to be secured for GCSE English (both Language and Literature).

Learners on this provision will have 4 lessons of English each week and study a Shakespeare play, a modern play, a pre-1914 text and as well as using anthologies of extracts covering both fiction and non-fiction texts. In addition, learners on the Boost provision will also study a range of poetry as dictated by the exam board at the time.

Most learners on the Boost provision are working towards at least Entry Level 2 in English although there are likely to be several learners who will be working towards gaining a GCSE in English Language and/or Literature.
