


We study lots of subjects including:

REEC has been through quite the makeover this last academic year!







- Who? Year 12/13/14 mixed groups based on 'stage not age'
- Where? REEC
- **How?** 2 year rolling programme 2 days a week working on a half termly 'project' (BTEC briefs) focused on Hospitality and Retail skills and industries. They will also partake in the 'Young Enterprise Team Programme'.

Overview of some skills covered:

- Incorporated Functional Literacy, Numeracy and ICT/ administration skills
- Catering/ safe food handling skills and practices
- Domestics/ cleaning skills
- Enterprise Skills Marketing, Sales, Finance, Management, Teamwork and Customer Service
- Possible industry standard qualifications Food Hygiene, COSHH, Moving and Handling, First Aid

Things to consider when choosing this course:


- You will be working with the public

- You will learn to understand the importance of good personal and environmental hygiene.


















BTEC COURSE 2 – CONSTRUCTION & HORTICULTURE

- Who? Year 12/13 mixed groups based on 'stage not age'
- Where? REEC
- **How?** 2 year rolling programme 2 days a week working on a half termly 'project' (BTEC briefs) focused on Construction and Horticulture skills and industries. They may also take part in the Rochdale Council gardening project.

Overview of some skills covered:

- Incorporated Functional Literacy, Numeracy and ICT/ administration skills
- Gardening skills such as looking after and growing plants and keeping outside spaces clean and tidy
- Construction skills such a brick laying and woodwork
- DIY/ decorating skills
- Teamwork skills
- Possible industry standard gualifications Moving and Handling, First Aid
- Designing and creating product or services for sale









BTEC COURSE 2 – CONSTRUCTION & HORTICULTURE

• You will need to be determined and know how to work in a team as well as independently.
































BTEC COURSE 3 – CARE & WELLNESS
